In order to have a whole hog contest this year, the following needs to happen. We need a minimum of 24 teams or individuals doing whole hog for Meadow Creek Welding and Martin's Custom Butchering to sponsor the event. We are opening up the contest to include individuals who only want to do whole hog and not the other KCBS meats. We are setting up 2 fee structures.

Teams entered in the KCBS contest and whole hog.....\$25.00 (above the site fees)

**Teams/Individuals entered in the whole hog only.....\$100.00 (covers site fee)

** (You will get a 10' by 10' space on the street with access to water. Electricity is an additional \$35.00)

This entry fee must be on a separate check which we will hold until we are assured of having 24 whole hog entries. We will inform you by August 15 if the contest is a go.

Meadow Creek Welding can deliver to New Holland Park, pick up and clean one of their PR60 pig roasters for \$75.00. Contact Melvin Stoltzfus at 717-354-7533. He can also arrange for delivery of your hog. 1 week advance notice and desired weight of hog is required. Cash on delivery to Martin's Custom Butchering.

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Whole Hog Contest

Sponsored by Meadow Creek Welding & Martin's Custom Butchering

Rules

1. Hog must weigh minimum of 75 pounds dressed with head intact.
2. All KCBS rules apply.
3. Contestant must furnish own hog or make arrangements with Martin's Custom Butchering in New Holland 717-355-9601.
4. Hog must be inspected by meat inspector prior to applying any rubs, marinades or injections.
5. Contestant may use any rubs, sauces or injections as deemed appropriate.
6. Hog must be cooked on site over wood or charcoal.

Judging is based on 5 different cuts from the hog.

Blind judging by certified KCBS judges.

Turn in time 3:00 PM at judge's room.

KCBS rules apply as far as garnish.

Special containers will be supplied

At least 6 samples of 5 different cuts must be entered: shoulder, loin, rib meat, bacon & ham.

Samples will be placed in specific spots in the container. A layout is shown below.

Champion receives a trophy and \$500.00

Reserve receives a trophy and \$400.00

3rd Place receives a trophy and \$300.00

4th Place receives a plaque and \$200.00

5th Place receives a plaque and \$100.00

7. A Pig Patrol will visit each contestant 1 hour prior to turn in to ensure that all rules are being followed.
8. Please check schedule for correct turn-in time.
