



Competition/Team Rules

Team Information:

1. BBQ is fun. Please enjoy this competition.
2. The number of teams will be limited due to space constraints.
3. Team cooks must be members of the first responder unit listed on the team application. No ringers.
4. Teams will be assigned a 10X10 area and may set up starting at 10 AM on Friday August 24. Space is at a premium so all teams are asked to observe property boundaries.
5. **Each team will receive 30 lbs. of wings.**
6. Teams are responsible for providing all equipment and supplies to safely handle, prepare and serve the wings. This would include but is not limited to cooker, gloves, serving pans, utensils, and a thermometer.
7. Teams may cook with electric, propane, wood, charcoal or pellets. Fuel supply and cooking methods are the team's choice.

Food Safety:

1. Teams must have a cooler with ice to store the wings between delivery and cooking.
2. Food safety and proper food handling practices are a must.
 - a. Uncooked wings must be maintained at less than 40^oF.
 - b. Wings must be cooked to an internal temperature of 165^oF.
 - c. Cooked Wings must be held at an internal temperature of at least 140^oF.
3. All preparation, seasoning and cooking must be done in the team's assigned area.

Wing Competition Information:

1. A mandatory cooks meeting will be held at 5 PM on Friday, August 24 at a location to be announced at a later date.
2. Wings should be available for the public by 5:45PM on August 24. Serving will continue until supply is exhausted.
3. Awards will be at approximately 8:30 PM on August 24 at the stage.
4. The committee will be responsible for ticket sales. One ticket gets one wing. No additional food or any other items may be sold or given away at your site.
5. Ash cans and trash cans will be provided. It is your responsibility to keep your site clean.
6. Water - A hose will be provided for your water needs.
7. Electricity - The committee will supply lighting for the sight. Teams will be responsible for supplying electricity for any other needs.
8. Each site must have a minimum 5 lb. ABC fire extinguisher.
9. We are not responsible for the loss of any items at your site.
10. Sites must be torn down and cleaned up by 9 PM.

Failure to abide by the rules will result in disqualification.
